The Center for Applied Drama and Autism is seeking original, one-act scripts for its upcoming one-act festival that are written by playwrights on the Autism spectrum or who have other developmental or physical disabilities. The festival is scheduled to run March 5 - 7, 2021 with the play readings performed virtually via Zoom.

Submission Requirements:

- Scripts must be the playwrights original work.
- Submission is open to any theme/genre.
- Estimated read time of the script should be 30 minutes or less.
- A smaller cast size is preferred and will be considered first.
- Please include a title page with your play that includes: the play title, the playwright's name, the number of characters, approximate read time, and contact information for the playwright (email address & phone number).
- All play submissions must be sent as a PDF.
- The play submission deadline is **Friday, October 30, 2020.**
